

SMS – Regulatory

What is it?

SMS regulations explain the specific, performance-based, components and elements your certificate holders must comply with. These regulations can be based on materials such as those promulgated by International Organizations or best practices (which are derived from ISR's extensive SMS experience). Assisting those regulations are documents such as acceptable means of compliance and/or guidance material.



Why do it?

Before a regulator can ask its certificate holders to implement an SMS, that regulator must first have the appropriate framework (regulations, guidance materials, etc.).
